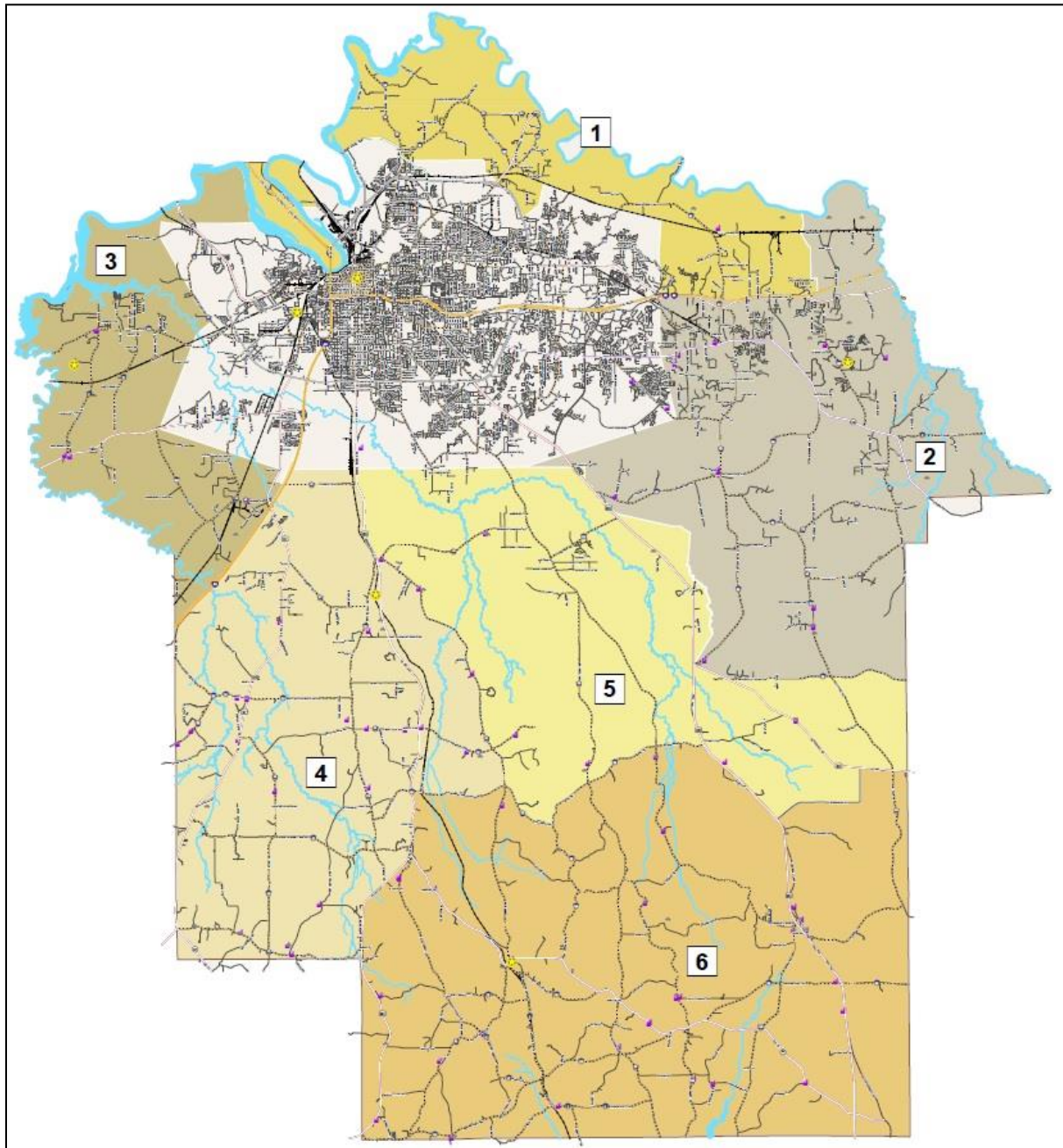

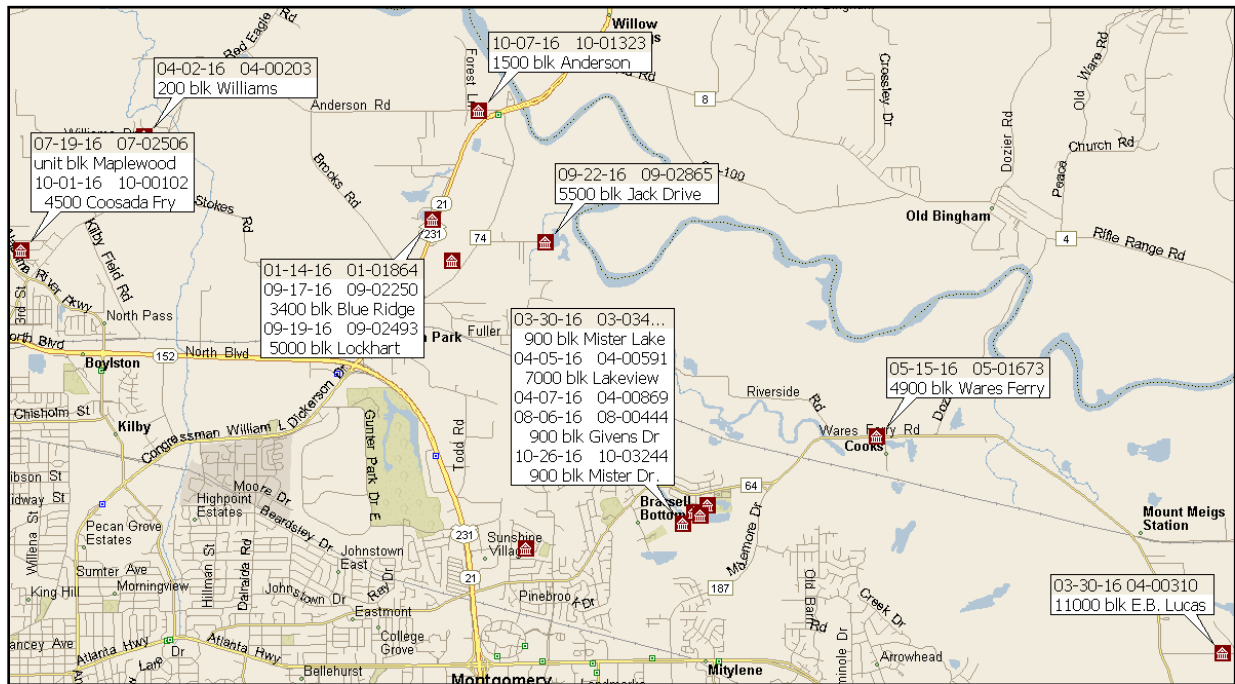

In mid-October a person riding his bicycle in the area of Alabama River Parkway in district 1 was confronted by a subject who presented a gun and robbed the victim of the bicycle and other personal property. The offender then shot the victim in the leg and fled on the bicycle. While M.C.S.O. personnel were assisting the victim, a second victim in the same area called to report an attempt by an armed individual to stop her vehicle. She also reported being shot at when she accelerated her vehicle in fleeing from the subject. A lookout was placed to area law enforcement and the suspect was arrested by members of the Millbrook Police Department responding to the Parkway area on the their side of the river.

Charges: Burglary III, Theft I

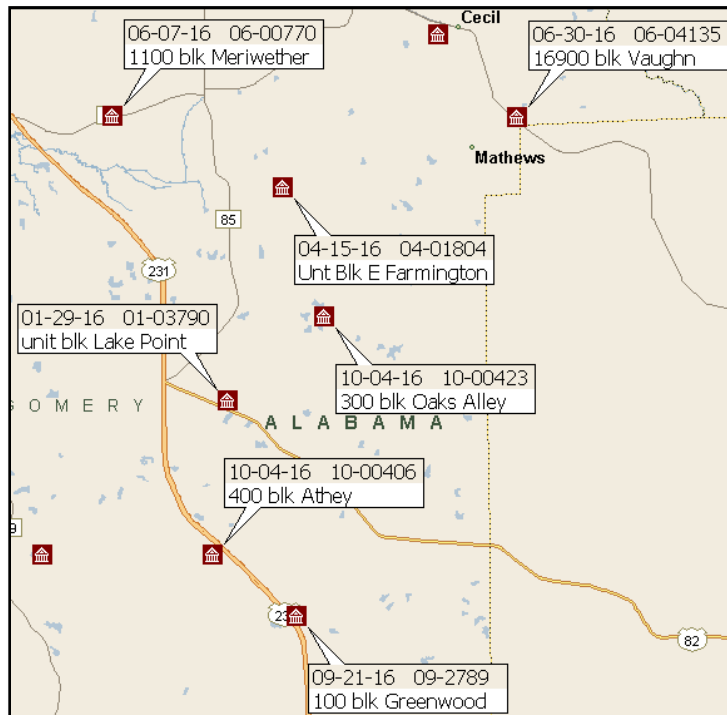

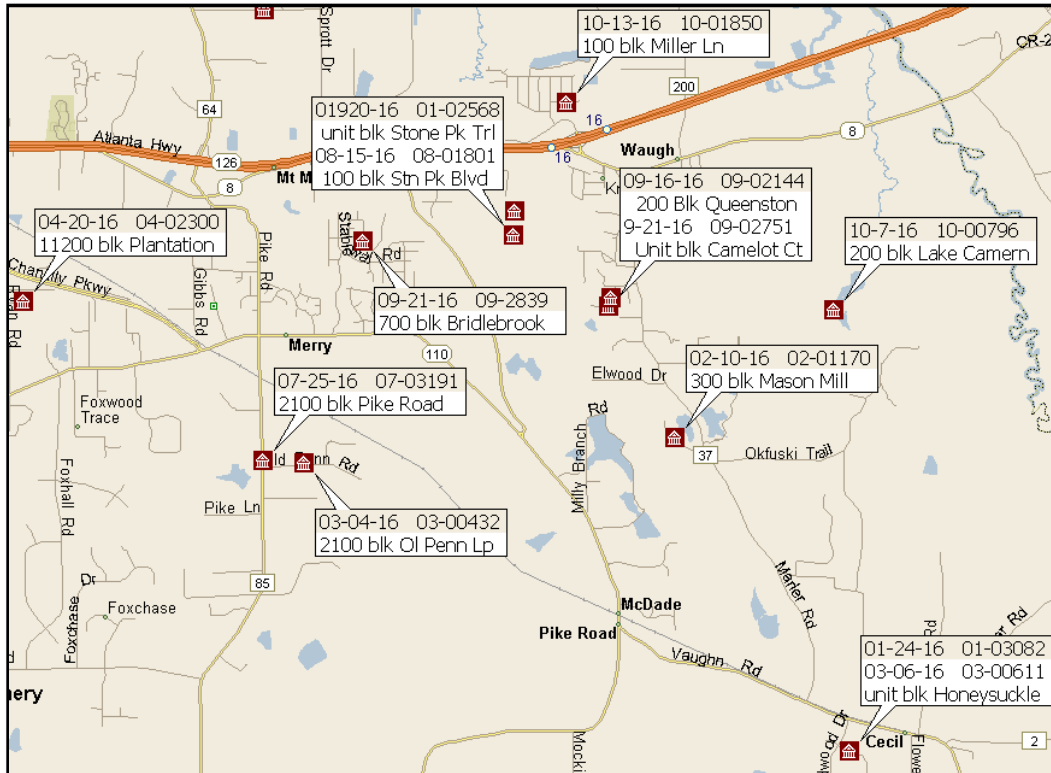

On an early morning in late July a District 2 resident called M.C.S.O. Dispatch to report a car driving slowly through the area as two persons on foot pulled on door handles of parked cars. M.C.S.O. units were dispatched; Deputies spotted the vehicle and upon checking the tag, found the vehicle had been reported stolen. They activated emergency equipment and attempted to stop the vehicle which sped off attempting to elude them. A chase ensued; the vehicle's tires were spiked causing it to run off the road; and the three occupants arrested. The below person as well as two juveniles have been charged in the cases.

Arrested: Isaiah Dajuan Marshall age 18 of Montgomery and two juveniles.
Charges: Unlawful Breaking/entering a vehicle (2 counts), Theft II (1 count); Theft III (1 ct); Receiving Stolen Property (1 ct); Attempting to Elude (1 count).

A District 2 victim had his motorcycle stolen by a prospective buyer he had contacted through a social media “for sale” site. The offender asked to meet with the victim to examine and test drive the motorcycle and when the victim complied, the suspect fled with the motorcycle. M.C.S.O. Deputies broadcast a description of the property and offender to local law enforcement and the suspect and motorcycle were spotted by Montgomery Police Officers who detained him. Arrested: Gerrod Pierre Scott age 18, of Montgomery.

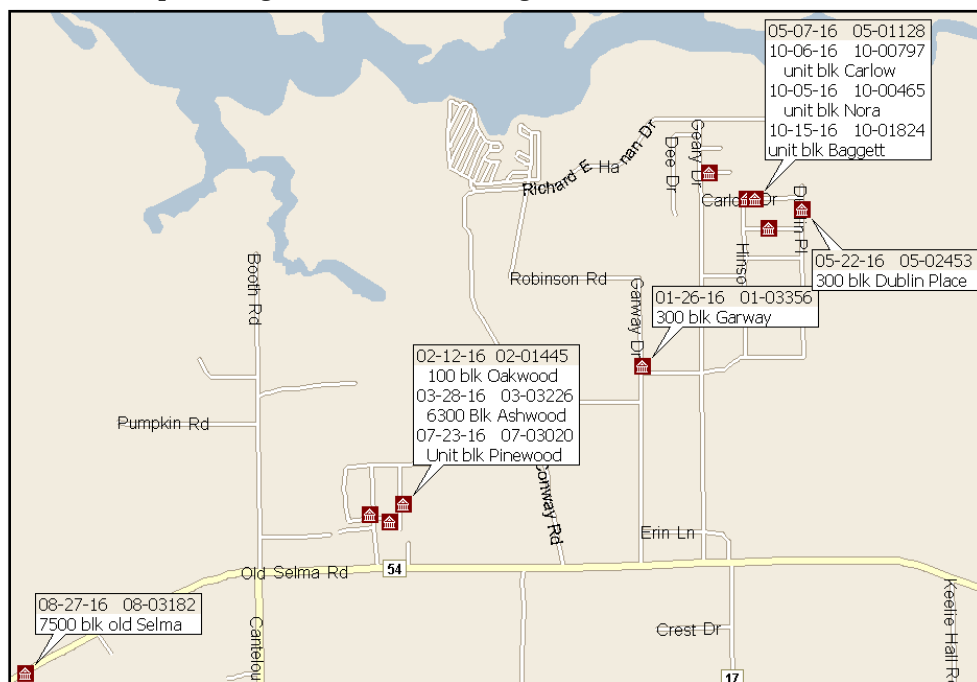

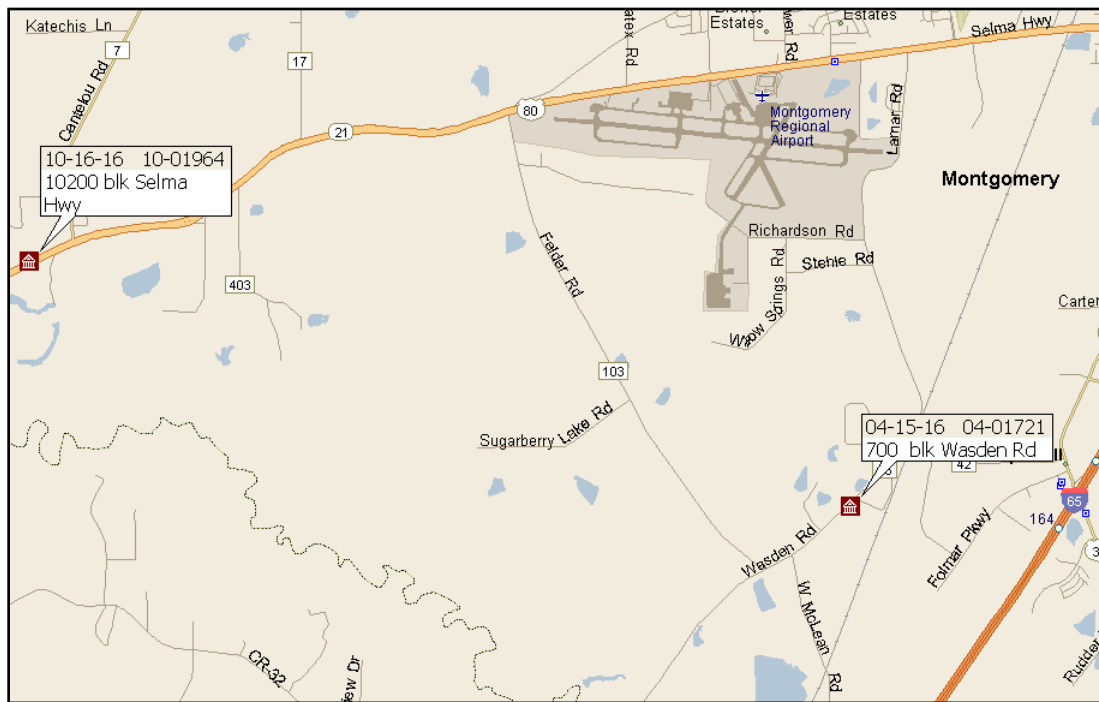

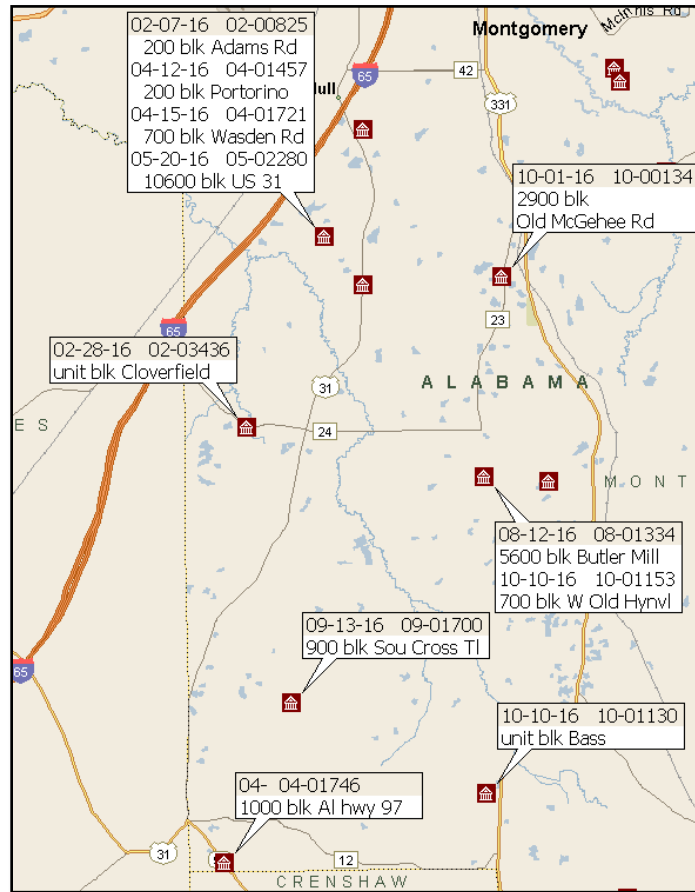

In late a September a Montgomery resident was shot and left lying beside the roadway in district 4. The offender fled the scene in the victim's vehicle. Responding Deputies alerted other units giving a description of the vehicle as well as the name of the offender which had been given by the victim. Deputy James Richardson spotted the vehicle in district 1 off US 231 north of Montgomery and activated emergency equipment to stop the suspect. The offender sped away but after a brief pursuit abandoned her vehicle and fled on foot. Deputy Richardson continued his pursuit on foot; the offender was overtaken; and resisted arrest causing minor injuries to Deputy Richardson as he attempted to handcuff her. She has been charged with the below offenses.

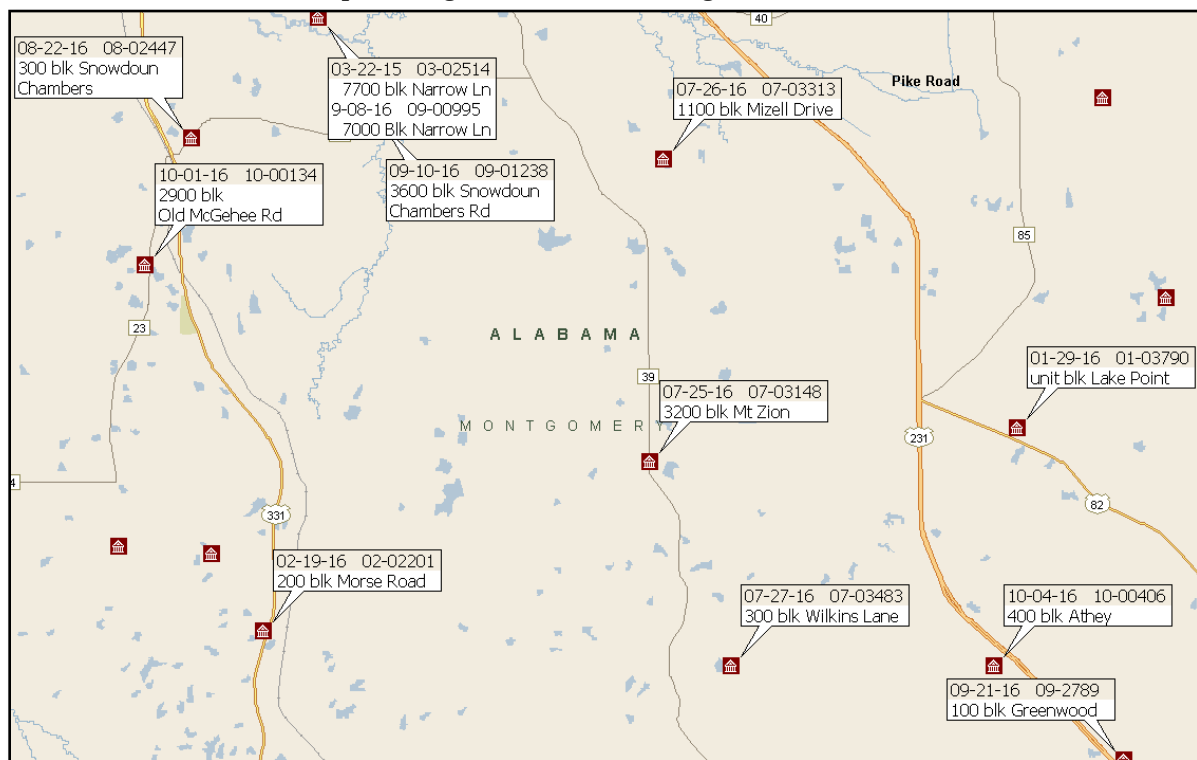

Map showing 2016 Residential Burglaries in District 5



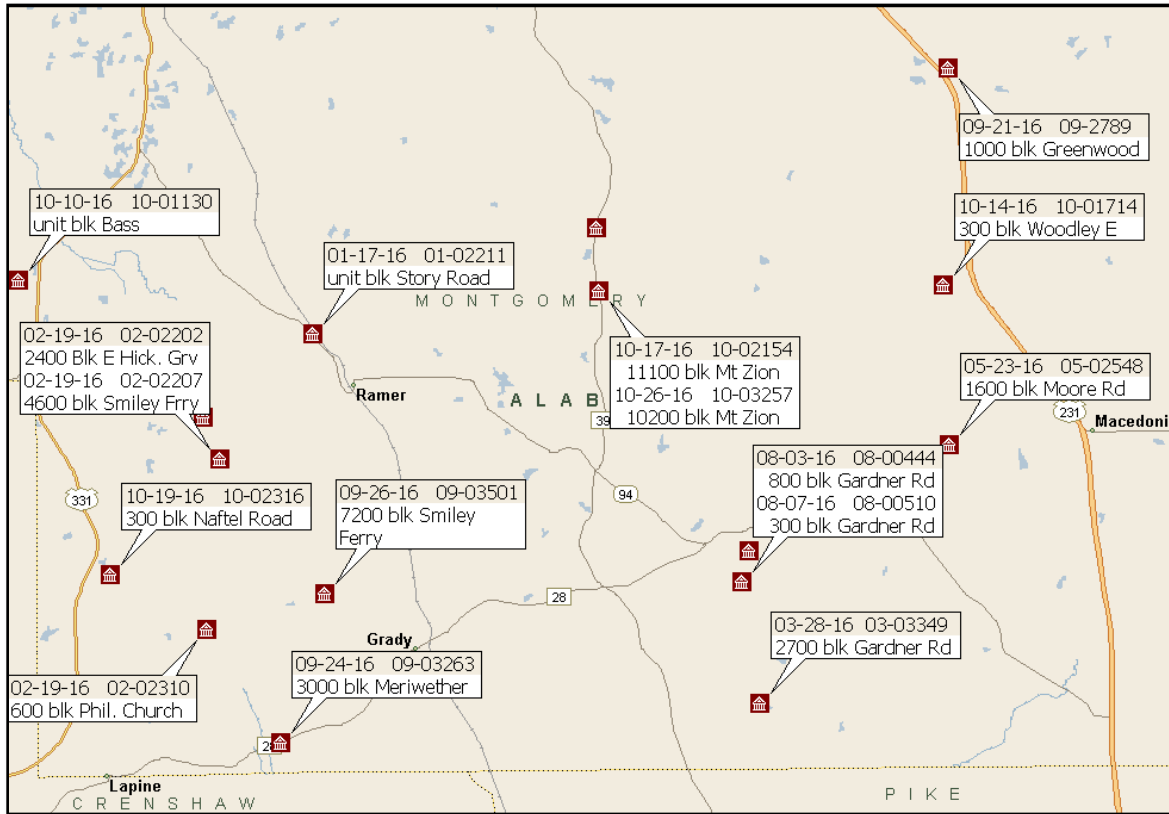

The Montgomery County Sheriff's Office is now accepting applications for our *Citizens Academy*. The Citizens Academy was established in 1997 to educate the citizens of Montgomery County on how the Sheriff's Office operates and to promote public safety among our community members. Citizens are given an opportunity to ride with a Deputy on patrol, tour the County Jail, volunteer at events that are sponsored by the Sheriff's Office as well as train on the Firearms Training Simulator.
