Based on funding from the Alabama State Legislature, anticipated yearly funding is projected to be four hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$490,000) for fiscal year 2021 and fiscal year 2022. Therefore, the successful Provider will receive state funding for approximately four hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$490,000), flowing through Montgomery County from November 2, 2020 – September 30, 2021.

Amend as follows

Based on funding from the Alabama State Legislature, anticipated yearly funding is projected to be four hundred seven thousand dollars (\$407,000) for fiscal year 2021 and fiscal year 2022. Therefore, the successful Provider will receive state funding for approximately four hundred seven thousand dollars (\$407,000), flowing through Montgomery County from November 2, 2020 – September 30, 2021.

For each service and/or treatment cycle, the DT will have the capacity to serve approximately twenty-four (24) juvenile offenders through the Transitions Program and up to twelve (12) parents, depending on enrollment, through the Parent Project Program.

Amend as follows

For each service and/or treatment cycle, the DT will have the capacity to serve approximately thirty-six (36) juvenile offenders through the Transitions Program and up to twelve (12) parents, depending on enrollment, through the Parent Project Program.

Section VI: Proposal Requirements (Requirements for the Business Proposal)

To establish that total DT costs (before MEDICAID reimbursement) are no more than four hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$490,000).

Amend as follows

To establish that total DT costs (before MEDICAID reimbursement) are no more than four hundred seven thousand dollars (\$407,000).
