Languages and Scripts: The entire collection is recorded in English.

Administrative/Biographical History: Lyn Frazer, creator of the Lyn Frazer Collection, has long actively worked as an archivist in Montgomery, Alabama. During the mid-2000s, up until 2012, Lyn Frazer worked as county archivist for Montgomery County, Alabama. Prior to her employment with Montgomery County, Frazer served as an archivist with the Alabama Department of Archives and History. After leaving her post at the Montgomery County Archives, Frazer became archivist for Montgomery's First United Methodist Church Archives.

Scope and Content: The Lyn Frazer Collection consists of a single photograph of a woman named Carrie Melton Hill. The photograph, taken on August 26, 1902, depicts Hill in her wedding dress and veil.

System of Arrangement: This collection is organized into one series.

Custodial History: Lyn Frazer held the Lynn Frasier Collection until she donated it to the Montgomery County Archives on January 4, 2019.

Processing Information: Dallas Hanbury processed the collection on January 7, 2019. Processing consisted of placing the collection into an archival quality container and creating a finding aid for the collection.

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Related Materials: John and Johanna Dowe's wills—the grandparents of John Dowe, the creator of this collection—are accessible at the MCA. The MCA also possesses a 2001 deed and preservation easement between John Dowe and the National Trust for Historic Preservation. Furthermore, the MCA also holds an executor's deed in which John Dowe's estate transferred to the Alabama Historical Commission ownership of the Dowe family house and property at 334 Washington Avenue, Montgomery, Alabama.
